Equipment/Regulations

The following equipment is mandatory for the camp:

- ► Pair of skimountaineering skis with metallic edges. The binding must allow heel movement when ascending and must release frontally and laterally.
- ► Skimountaineering boots that cover the ankles with a minimum depth of sole notches of 4mms
- ► A pair of ski poles with non-metallic baskets
- ► A Backpack with 20 liters minimum volume and a fastening system for the skis
- ► A pair of skins
- ► Avalanche beacon which conforms to standard frequency 457 KHz
- ► Shovel & probe
- ► Emergency blanket
- ► helmet (bicycle or climbing helmets allowed)
- beanie or headband
- gloves that cover the entire hand
- ► upper body clothing: three long layers, if possible one layer water- and windproof
- ► lower body clothing: Two long layers/ a pair of longjohns
- ► climbing gear if at hand

For the races the current German skimountaineering rules are valid. See: alpenverein.de \to Spitzenbergsport \to Skibergsteigen \to Reglement

Skimountaineering is an outdoor sports activity and is potentially hazardous. Therefore a special insurance is reccomended.
